### Medical Information

When an animal is given to the HSFC, a full medical exam is our first order of business to ensure the animal is healthy and to arrange for his/her proper medical care if any problems are noted. Medical and lab work are completed according to the animal's age.

All animals accepted into the HSFC program receive general examinations and proper medical care according to the following schedule.
